MEDIA INSTRUCTIONS FOR 2023 MINNESOTA HIGH SCHOOL FOOTBALL ALL-STAR GAME TO BE HELD AT U.S. BANK STADIUM SATURDAY, DECEMBER 2

Event celebrating football in Minnesota includes three-day training camp and culminates with 50th annual All-Star Football Game.

The Minnesota High School Football All-Star Game, developed in partnership between the Minnesota Vikings and the Minnesota Football Coaches Association (MFCA), will take place at U.S. Bank Stadium Saturday, December 2. This will be the 50th annual All-Star Football Game highlighting outstanding senior football players from around the state.

Tickets are now available with all proceeds going directly to the MFCA and the Tackle Cancer Campaign.

Kicking off at 1:00 PM, the All-Star Game will be the 61st overall in Minnesota high school football history. The All-Star Game has been an annual event since 1974.

The game will feature the North All-Stars vs. the South All-Stars. Jack Negen of Robbinsdale Armstrong (North) and Nick David of Mound Westonka (South) will serve as the game's head coaches.

About the All-Star Game

The Minnesota Football Coaches Association is proud of this game and its history. The first All-Star Football Game was played in 1945, and the game has been an annual event since 1974. The All-Star Game has been played in two formats: North vs. South format from 1945 through 1960 and from 1974 to 1979, a Metro vs. Outstate format from 1980 to 2010 and back to a North vs. South format in 2011 (to present). The South All-Stars lead the current North vs South series 10-2. The South also leads the all-time North vs South series 18-10-1. Through the years, over 4,900 players and 500 coaches have participated in this game. A total of 104 players from the All-Star Football Game have gone on to play or coach in the National Football League, including current Minnesota Vikings FB **C.J. Ham** (2011 All-Star).



- Take Exit 8B to merge onto 94-E
- Take Exit 233C to merge onto 35-W N.
- Take Exit 17 C (3rd Street U of M)
- Stay left and take 3rd Street Exit.
- Take 3rd Street to Norm McGrew PI, turn left into lot.

I-35W SOUTHBOUND

- Take Exit 17 C for Washington Ave.
- Turn left onto Washington Ave S.
- Washington Ave turns into Cedar Ave
- Turn right and merge onto 3rd St S.
- Take 3rd Street to Norm McGrew PI, turn left into lot.

I-35W NORTHBOUND
